#### 1. Admissions schedule



Registration and submission of the application in the <u>IRK system</u>: 15 April – 29 May 2025

30 May -4 June 2025 – formal verification of the applications

By 5 June 2025 – informing candidates about mistakes in the IRK application form

By 9 June 2025 – deadline for rectyfing the obvious mistakes in the IRK application form

10 June 2025 – leaving applications with mistakes unprocessed

- Qualification proceedings:
  - 1st stage (research projects and scientific activity): 11 23 June 2025,
  - publication of the 1st stage results: by 26 June 2025,
  - publication of the interviews schedule (2nd stage): by 26 June 2025,
  - deadline for submitting applications to conduct the intreviews remotely: by 28 June 2025,
  - o <u>2nd stage (interviews): 3 15 July 2025,</u>
  - o publication of the ranking list: by 21 July 2025,
  - Accepting documents from candidates recommended to be admitted: 28 July 22 September 2025,
  - Publication of the list of admitted candidates: by 30 September 2025.



### 2. Assessment criteria in the 1st stage



Maximum number of points: 60 (number of points required to qualify for the second stage - 30 pts).

#### • Criteria:

- Initial description of the research project (maximum number of points 40):
  - purpose of the research (0–10 points);
  - novelty and originality of the research project (0-10 points)
  - methodology appropriate for the objective pursued, consistency of argumentation, transparency of reasoning (0-10 points);
  - description of the current status of research with references relevant for the research objective (0-10 points);
- Scientific activity of the candidate (maximum number of points 20). When evaluating scientific activity, the following elements, confirmed by means of scanned documents, shall be taken into account:
  - scientific publications, including scientific articles, sections in multi-author monographs, single-author monographs, publications in peer-reviewed international conferences materials (0-8 points);
  - presentations at national and international scientific conferences with an approved paper (0-8 points)
  - other elements of the evaluation of the candidate's experience and scientific achievements, including awards, honourable mentions, certificates, professional experience, teaching experience, activity in an academic scientific movement, training, promotion of science, etc. (0–4 points).).

#### The conditions for qualification for the 2nd stage are:

- 1) Receiving at least 30 pts, and
- 2) Placement within twice the number of places available at the School in a given discipline.



### 2. Assessment criteria in the 2nd stage



- Maximum number of points: 40 (number of points required to be recommended for admission- 20 pts).
- Criteria:
  - 1) the candidate's competencies relevant for the research conducted, including an understanding of the research topic to be undertaken and subject knowledge (0-20 pts);
  - 2) ability to justify the appropriateness of the choice of discipline and linguistic correctness, including in particular fluency in the use of scientific language appropriate to the discipline of the research being undertaken (0-20 points).
- The interview is be held in Polish with elements of English or entirely in English, according to candidate's preferences indicated in the IRK system.
- The interview with the candidate shall be no shorter than 15 minutes, unless the candidate finishes it early.
- The interview is recorded.


#### The conditions for recommendation to be admitted to the School are:

- 1) Receiving at least 30 pts from the 1st stage, and
- 2) Receiving at least 20 pts from the 2nd stage, and
- 3) Placement within the number of places available at the School in a given discipline.





The resume or CV should mainly refer to the candidate's scientific publications and scientific conferences that they attended. Additional points may be awarded for other activities, including participation in training, certificates, promotion of science or activity in the academic scientific movement. The activity should relate to the last five calendar years preceding the application. If a candidate became a parent during this time, as evidenced by a scan of the child's birth certificate attached to the application, this period shall be extended by two years for each child. The scan of the child's birth should be uploaded as one file with the CV/resume.

#### Scans of materials evidencing scientific activity mentioned in CV or resume

Scientific activity that is not evidenced by scans will not be taken into consideration in the qualification proceedings. Scans of title pages confirm scientific publications. It is also possible to attach a maximum of two scans of complete texts of publications which the candidate considers the most important. Confirmation of participation in scientific conferences is provided by scans of certificates of participation issued by the conference organisers or scans of conference programmes. Scans of certificates, attestations and other relevant documents shall provide confirmation of other activities. If the documents confirming scientific activity have been issued in a language other than Polish or English, the candidate must attach their working translation to the application. All materials confirming scientific activity should be combined in one PDF file (no page limit).



#### § 6

- 1. The Admissions Coordinator shall organize the admissions procedure to the School, including:
- 1) publishing the composition of qualification teams on the School's website;
- 2) supervising the correct operation of the IRK system as part of the School admissions procedure;
- 3) supervising the School's process of accepting documents from candidates;
- 4) posting instructions, in Polish and in English, on how to properly complete the application for admission to the School in the IRK system;
- 5) based on the submitted documents, reviewing the circumstances regarding the initiation of qualification proceedings, mentioned in particular under § 14 and § 15, section 4;
- 6) informing candidates about the obvious mistakes and/or errors mentioned under § 15, section 3, within no more than seven days after the expiry of the document submission deadline set forth under § 4, section 1;

#### § 15

3. In particularly justified cases, upon the candidate's request submitted within no more than 10 days following the expiry of the deadline for document submission, as set forth under §4, section 1, the Director may consent to the rectification of obvious mistakes and/or errors, if such rectification concerns the parts of the application that do not influence the assessment mentioned under §18, section 1.



#### 6. Most common mistakes



- No certified translation of the diploma issued in a language other than Polish or English.
- 2. Lack of number of doctoral students under the supervision of the planned supervisor in the declaration of the planned supervisor
- 3. The person who is the planned supervisor is not an employee of the University or is not a person with a postdoctoral degree.
- 4. Lack of signatures and dates in the submitted documents.
- 5. Lack of scans of materials confirming scientific activity **not subject to rectification!**
- 6. Lack of legalisation of a diploma issued abroad (apostille/legalization)

§ 15

8. The application mentioned under section 1 should be completed in Polish and/or English. The candidate is required to submit a certified translation into Polish and/or English of documents mentioned under section 1, point 2. In case of doubt about these documents, the Admissions Coordinator requests more information from the Director of the Polish National Agency for Academic Exchange, mentioned under Article 326, section 4 of the Act. <sup>24</sup>While awaiting information on a candidate from the Director of the National Academic Exchange Agency, the admission process for that candidate is not suspended. The candidate is also required to submit translations of their scientific achievement awards mentioned under section 1, points 4 to 5. In justified cases, the Admissions Coordinator, the chairperson and/or the secretary of the qualification team may request the candidate to submit translations of other documents and/or materials included in the application by a designated deadline.

§ 30

3. In justified cases, the Director may condition a candidate's entry into the list of doctoral students on submitting a translation of a specific document, including a sworn translation or legalization (apostille) of the document, by a specific and reasonable deadline. A condition may also be imposed by means of an administrative decision.



### 7. Diploma legalisation – how?



**An apostille** is a certification of the official character of a national document needed if it is to be used abroad. It confirms the signature and the nature in which the person who signed the document acted, as well as the identity of the seal on the document.

Recognition of an apostille from States party to the Convention of 5 October 1961 Abolishing the Requirement of Legalisation for Foreign Public Documents.

If the country in which the diploma was issued is not party to this convention, the document must be legalised (e.g. Egypt).

#### § 17

- 1. The admissions procedure is conducted on a fee basis.
- 3. In the event that a candidate takes part in more than one qualification proceedings to a School, they shall pay an admission fee for each of them.
- 4. The candidate shall pay the admission fee no later than on the next day after the closing date for the document submission process, as set forth in accordance with § 4, section 1. The day of payment shall be the day when the appropriate amount is credited to the University account. The application of a candidate who failed to pay the whole admission fee in a timely manner shall be left unexamined by the Director.
- 5. The candidate makes a payment to an individual bank account generated in the IRK system.
